2013 TIGER Grants Announced - Springfield Rail Improvement Project Receives Grant

U.S. Transportation Secretary Anthony Foxx has announced that 52 transportation projects in 37 states will receive a total of approximately \$474 million from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) 2013 discretionary grant program.

The Carpenter Street underpass rail improvement project in Springfield is one of the grant recipients. The project received a \$14,400,000 TIGER grant.
