Attention Amtrak Customers

Due to track work being performed by Union Pacific Railroad, Amtrak *Lincoln* and *Texas Eagle* Service will be affected on May 17 through 21, as follows:

Service Change

Lincoln Service, Thursday, May 17:

- Train 300, which normally operates between St. Louis and Chicago, will be cancelled. Alternate transportation will be provided, via Bus 3300, for missed stops at Springfield, Lincoln, Bloomington-Normal, Pontiac, Dwight, Joliet and Summit. No alternate transportation will be provided for missed stops at St. Louis, Alton or Carlinville.
 - o **Bus 5000** will make limited intermediate stops at Springfield, Bloomington-Normal, Joliet and Chicago, only.
- Train 302, which normally operates between St. Louis and Chicago, will be cancelled. Alternate transportation will be provided, via Bus 3302, for missed stops at Alton, Carlinville, Springfield, Lincoln, Bloomington-Normal, Pontiac, Dwight, Joliet and Summit.
 - o Bus 5002 will make limited intermediate stops at Alton, Springfield, Bloomington-Normal and Joliet.
- Trains 301 and 303, which normally operate between Chicago and St. Louis, will be cancelled. Alternate transportation will be provided, via Bus 3301 and 3303.
 - o **Bus 3301** will make stops at Joliet, Bloomington-Normal, Springfield and Alton.
 - Bus 3303 will make stops at Summit, Joliet, Dwight, Pontiac, Bloomington-Normal, Lincoln, Springfield, Carlinville
 and Alton
 - o **Bus 5003** will make limited intermediate stops at Joliet, Bloomington-Normal, Springfield and Alton.
- Train 305 may experience delays of approximately 60 minutes.

Lincoln Service, Friday, May 18 through Monday, May 21:

- Train 300, which normally operates between St. Louis and Chicago, will be cancelled. Alternate transportation will be provided, via Bus 3300, for missed stops at Springfield, Lincoln, Bloomington-Normal, Pontiac, Dwight, Joliet and Summit. No alternate transportation will be provided for missed stops at St. Louis, Alton or Carlinville.
 - o **Bus 5000** will make limited intermediate stops at Springfield, Bloomington-Normal, Joliet and Chicago, only.
- Train 302, which normally operates between St. Louis and Chicago, will be cancelled. Alternate transportation will be provided, via Bus 3302, for missed stops at Alton, Carlinville, Springfield, Lincoln, Bloomington-Normal, Pontiac, Dwight, Joliet and Summit.
 - Bus 5002 will make limited intermediate stops at Alton, Springfield, Bloomington-Normal and Joliet.
- Trains 301 and 303, which normally operate between Chicago and St. Louis, will be cancelled. Alternate transportation will be provided, via Bus 3301 and 3303.
 - o **Bus 3301** will make stops at Joliet, Bloomington-Normal, Springfield and Alton.
 - Bus 3303 will make stops at Summit, Joliet, Dwight, Pontiac, Bloomington-Normal, Lincoln, Springfield, Carlinville and Alton.
 - Bus 5003 will make limited intermediate stops at Joliet, Bloomington-Normal, Springfield and Alton.

Texas Eagle Service, Thursday, May 17 through Monday, May 21:

- **Southbound Train 21/421** will detour between Chicago and St. Louis, missing stops at Joliet, Pontiac, Bloomington-Normal, Lincoln, Springfield, Carlinville and Alton. No alternate transportation will be provided for missed stops.
 - o Passengers traveling from Chicago to St. Louis and points south will remain on Train 21.
- **Northbound Train 22/422** will detour between St. Louis and Chicago, missing stops at Alton, Carlinville, Springfield, Lincoln, Bloomington-Normal, Pontiac and Joliet. No alternate transportation will be provided for missed stops.
 - o Passengers traveling through to Chicago will remain on **Train 22.**
 - Passengers destined to intermediate stops will detrain at St. Louis and transfer to Bus 3322.
- Trains 321 and 322 are cancelled with no alternate transportation provided. Passengers may use other Lincoln Service trains
- Trains 21 and 22 may incur up to 60 minutes in delays along the detour route.
